



WGSA PERFORMANCE RANKING

“Counting Rounds: Best 80% of differentials | Minimum number of Rounds: 40% of all rounds played”

- Championship Division players only.
- “Counting Rounds” are taken from Open National and Provincial Championships on the WGSA ranking list (currently 48 rounds in 19 tournaments – 2019).
- Minimum number of counting rounds to qualify for inclusion is 40%.
- Performance Rankings are based on a rolling calendar year (12 months).
- A dynamic rating is calculated for each round using a percentage of the field’s net scores.
- A stroke differential is calculated for each player using their gross score for that round minus the dynamic rating. Note: this is not an adjusted gross.
- The player’s current stroke differential, which is used for the Performance Ranking, is the average of the best 80% of her stroke differentials.

The Performance Ranking indicates how our top players perform under tournament conditions and is used by WGSA for selection purposes.
